Jannes Francisco (Progress Home and Office Furnishings)	With regard to the delivery period, can the PSA consider 90 to 120 days?	We can amend the delivery period to within 60 calendar days upon receipt of Notice to Proceed (NTP).
Jannes Francisco (Progress Home and Office Furnishings)	With regard to the SLCC, can the PSA consider compactors?	We will only consider Steel Racks.
Jojo Deocadiz (Tri-M Vault Specialist)	With regard to the Technical Specifications Page No. 31 Assembly – two sides with two vertical stoppers cross brace, so at each side there are two cross brace or two flat bars with cross? We are also requesting for an additional hard copy and/or USB copy. However, failure submit the additional hard copy and/or USB copy will not be a ground for disqualification.

NSB Engineering Design and Fabrication:	We recommend supply and delivery of metal fabrication.	The Technical Specifications provided in the Bidding Document remain the same.
Jojo Deocadiz (Tri-M Vault Specialist):	With regard to the Technical Specifications – Assembly, it is stated that “All parts are bolted at 1/4 x 5/8”. Normally, we use 1/4 x 1/2 inch.	The Technical Specifications provided in the Bidding Document remain the same.
Jojo Deocadiz (Tri-M Vault Specialist):	We purchased the bid documents yesterday, however, the sample forms were not included.	The sample forms will be provided to all bidders. Unfortunately, the PSA procurement website is under maintenance. However, the same is posted in the PhilGEPS website.
Jannes Francisco (Progress Home and Office Furnishings):	In case of the winning bidder, is there a need to submit a sample prior to the issuance of Notice to Proceed?	Yes. The winning bidder is required to submit or provide sample.
