If none, will the winning bidder be expected to provide internet connection between the Local Server and Central Server?</p>	<p>Yes, the PSA has existing internet connectivity from Central Office going to each Field Office.</p>

It should also have a data validation module to verify the correctness, accuracy, completeness of data being submitted, and a tabulation module to create the reports needed during data processing. The DPS should feature a client-server architecture that can support offline data processing. The DPS will be installed in the local server of the data processing center and connects to the central server via the internet. The client workstations must not have any connection to the internet.</p> <p>If the solution is on-premise, may we clarify if PSA will be the one to set-up or do the configuration to make the CAF-IS Application accessible using the internet connection?</p>	<p>PSA and Service Provider should be working closely together in setting up or doing the configuration.</p> <p>Moreover, Service Provider will provide training on the installation, configuration and management of the DPS and will provide technical assistance whether remotely or onsite when needed.</p>

And may we know the number of workstations needed or the number of workstations that will connect coming from the PSA Central Office?</p>	<p>Cloud hosting period starts on the development of the CAF-IS and for a duration of 12 months.</p> <p>PSA will provide at most 30 workstations in the Central Office.</p>
