Relevant Experience of the Consultant (10 Points)

The score for this criterion shall be based on similar work experience on completed consulting assignments, local or overseas. Projects with the biggest consultancy cost shall be considered in the evaluation

The formula for computation of the Relevant Experience of the Consultant was derived from the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) Department Order (DO) No. 143, series of 2022 adjusted according to the actual weight of this category to the total eligibility score of the consultant as prescribed in the PBD which is as follows:

Score (I) =
$$\left[0.60 + \frac{4}{30} \times \left(\frac{\text{TS}}{10} - 1\right)\right] \times 10'$$

Meaning of the Values:

- TS Total Score, number of similar experience of the firm, which shall refer to Project Management and/or Construction Management and Supervision of Building Construction projects as stated in the Eligibility Data Sheet item no. 9.1
- Also the Total number of Completed Contract multiplied to equivalent rating (maximum of 10 projects)
- 0.60 The base score factor given if the firm has completed at least one relevant project. It represents a starting point in the scoring formula. This ensures that even a firm with minimal relevant experience receives a portion of the total score.
- 10' The maximum number of points allocated to the "Relevant Experience of the Consultant" criterion. The entire expression within the brackets is multiplied by 10 to scale the result to this point system.
- 4 The maximum rating value a completed project can get according to the table (when the cost of the completed contract is 50% or more of the ABC).
- 10 The maximum number of projects considered for this formula
- -1 The maximum difference in rating (which is 3, since ratings range from 1 to 4 hence 4 - 1 = 3).

The rationale for the said formula is to consider the magnitude, complexity, and cost of the submitted completed projects relevant to the percentage of the ABC, wherein the top ten similar projects referring to Project Management and/or Construction Management and Supervision of Building Construction projects with the biggest consultancy cost shall be considered in the evaluation.

Qualification of the Key Personnel to be Assigned to the Consulting Services (60 Points)

The score for this criterion shall be rated based on the table below:
