According to the Secretariat Head, on the submission of the Single Largest Completed Contract (SLCC), the bidder should indicate the lot/s they are participating in and the bidder can submit one (1) SLCC for the lot they are participating in as long as it complies with the requirement of SLCC at least 50% of the ABC. The Secretariat Head added that each bidder is required to submit one copy of the first and second components of its Bid.
