<p>For Lot 1, Sensor Band Requirement</p> <p>“Panchromatic; Four (4) Multispectral (Blue, Green, Red, NIR) Sensor Resolution”</p> <p>While the bidder can provide the requirement, such is not reflected in their brochures. The only provisions indicated in the brochure is the maximum specification for sensor band that they can offer (i.e 8 sensor bands). The bidder inquired whether they will be disqualified should the requirement for 4 sensor bands cannot be seen in their documents.</p>	<p>The specification indicated in the PBD is the minimum requirement.</p>
<p>On the submission of bidding documents,</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Will the bidder include the USB inside the envelope (for bidding documents)? 2. How many copies of the bidding documents must be submitted? 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The bidder/s may submit the USB copy in an envelope which can be either placed inside the sealed bidding envelopes (for technical and financial components) OR in a separate envelope outside that of the bidding documents. 2. Per Section 15 of the Section II-Instruction to bidders, “Each Bidder shall submit one copy of the first and second components of its Bid”. Nevertheless, submission of an additional copy of the bidding document is much appreciated.
