



## **SUPPLEMENTAL BID BULLETIN NO. PB-2023-11-008**

Public Bidding No. 2023-007 27 November 2023

This Supplemental Bid Bulletin No. PB-2023-11-008 is issued to inform all prospective bidders of the amendments and clarifications in the bidding documents relative to the Procurement of 2024 Security Services for Philippine Statistics Authority 7 (PSA 7) for the Provinces of Bohol, Cebu, Negros Oriental, Siquijor and Regional Statistical Services Office for 01 January 2024 to 31 December 2024 (Early Procurement Activity).

PARTICULARS	CLARIFICATIONS
1. Clarification on the Technical Evaluation Parameters (supported by Company Profile) item 4 (d) Copies of the licenses, results of neuropsychiatric examination, training certificates and other requirements of the guards shall be furnished to PSA)	Under the Technical Specification, the Bidders must state either "Comply" or "Not Comply" against the parameters of each Technical Specification required.  For the Technical Evaluation Parameters (supported by Company Profile) item 4 (d), the bidder may or may not attach Copies of the licenses, results of the neuropsychiatric examination, training certificates, and other requirements of the guards. Nonattachment of the said documents will not result in the disqualification of the bidder during the opening of bids. However, during the post-qualification, the bidder shall present these documents for validation and verification by the RBAC or its Technical Working Group (TWG).
2. Clarification on the Technical Parameters Page 38, under other factors paragraph C Proof of paid remittances for the government agencies	Latest proof of remittances for the past six (6) months or one (1) year will be submitted as proof of paid remittances for the following government agencies: SSS, Philhealth, and PAG-IBIG in the form of a certification issued by the agency.

3. Clarification on the format of the Statement of all its ongoing government and private contracts including contracts awarded but not yet started, if there is any, and its attached documents upon submission.

There is no template provided for the Statement of all its ongoing government and private contracts including contracts awarded but not yet started but the bidder shall submit the document in matrix form with all the necessary information present in the required document.

The bidder may or may not attach all the supporting documents for all its ongoing government and private contracts including contracts awarded but not yet started. Non-attachment of the said documents will not result in the disqualification of the bidder. However, during the post-qualification, the bidder shall present these documents for validation and verification by the RBAC or its Technical Working Group (TWG).

4. Clarification on the number of days factor on the Detailed Computation of Bids

The 394.4 days factor is used for the Detailed Computation of Bids which is based on the Advisory No. 1-22A issued by the Department of Labor and Employment as the Suggested Contract Rates for the Security Services.

The PSA will revise the rates on the number of days if there are new regulatory issuances issued by the concerned agency.

5. Clarification on License issued by the appropriate government agencies required for the service Firearms certified true copy (Licenses issued by the appropriate government agencies required for the service Firearms issued through system generated or electronic signature is acceptable.)

Do we need to submit all the licenses of the firearms?

The bidder is required to submit the number of licensed firearms for its agency and the bidder may or may not attach the Licenses issued by the appropriate government agencies required for the service Firearms, however, during the post-qualification, the bidder shall present these documents for validation and verification by the RO7-BAC or its TWG.



6. Clarification on the Additional Parameters:

Must provide the following information

- (a) No. of Licensed Firearms
- (b) No. and Kind of Communication Devices
- (c) No. and Kind of Motor-Powered Vehicles
  - (d) No. of Licensed Guards by Sex

This statement is different on the requirement under 20. 2, Additional appropriate licenses, permits, and documents to be submitted

For C11 Additional parameters, the bidder is required to submit the number of licensed firearms for its agency, number and kind of Communication Devices, number and Kind of Motor-Powered Vehicles and No. of Licensed Guards by Sex.

For Clause 20.2 of the Bid Data Sheet (BDS), the bidder may or may not attach the Licenses issued by the appropriate government agencies required for the service Firearms, however, during the post-qualification, the bidder shall present these documents for validation and verification by the RO7-BAC or its TWG.

## 7. Clarification on the Additional Parameters:

Must have at least five (5) years of experience in providing security services to other government office.

There is an inconsistency on the statement under stability, item a. Years of Experience: at least five (5) years in front line security service

Kindly follow the TECHNICAL EVALUATION PARAMETERS item 1.a. The Bidder must have experience of at least five (5) years in front-line security service which includes services rendered to other government offices.

## 8. Clarification on the Additional Parameters:

Liquidity of the contractor: must have at least PhP 2,000,000.00 (current assets minus current liabilities based on Balance Sheet as of December 2022)

There is an inconsistency of the statement under Stability, item (c) Liquidity of the Contractor: At least Php500,000.00 (Current Assets minus stocks minus current liabilities based on latest Balance Sheet as of the previous fiscal year)

Kindly follow the TECHNICAL EVALUATION PARAMETERS item 1.c. The Liquidity of the Contractor must be at least Php500,000.00 (Current Assets minus stocks minus current liabilities based on the latest Balance Sheet as of the previous fiscal year).

9. Clarification on the additional parameters:	The inclusion of the parameter is for the
Must provide number of other personnel by Sex including supervisors/managers/other officers and its organizational structure	•
10. Clarification on the number of decimal places for the Detailed Computation of Bid.	Use two (2) decimal places in all computations for figures in Philippine Peso.
11. Clarification on the occurrence of a tie among bidders.	Based on Appendix 11 of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA 9184 and the GPPB CIRCULAR 06-2005 TIE-BREAKING METHOD, the procuring entity will use "draw lots" in cases of tie among bidders.
