As long as we are able to provide the total number of the required ports which are 4 USB 2.0 and 4 USB 3.0. This is to give way for other brands in the market, as not all models/brands have the same USB placement set-up.	The specifications indicated in the bidding documents remain unchanged.

13	Section VII – Technical Specifications On Audio jack Bidder's query: Can we add Audio Jack (2) or one (1) Universal Combo Jack. New models of desktop no longer use multiple audio jacks. Updated set-up is one (1) Universal Combo Jack that can accommodate both microphone and audio I/O.	The specifications under Rear I/O Connector on Audio Jack (3) is now amended to one (1) Universal Audio Jack and one (1) Line-out


