In lieu of the PhilGEPS Certificate of Registration and Membership, the following may be submitted pursuant to the Bayanihan Act and GPPB Resolution No. 06-2020:  (1) Mayor's or Business Permit (2) Income Tax Returns (Annual Income Tax Return of the preceding tax year) or Business Tax Returns (Value Added Tax or Percentage Tax Return covering the previous six months).	Yes, they are required.  However, pursuant to GPPB Resolution No. 09-2020 dated 07 May 2020, the Procuring Entity is allowed to accept alternate documentary requirements for procurement activities during a State of Calamity.
	If a bidder is not registered with PhilGEPS, items 1 and 2 will suffice?	Yes, in lieu of PhilGEPS Certificate of Registration, the enumerated Class "A" Documents listed below are acceptable.  (1) Mayor's or Business Permit; and (2) Income Tax Returns (Annual Income Tax Return of the preceding tax year) or Business Tax Returns (Value Added Tax or Percentage Tax Return covering the previous six months).  The Bidder shall be allowed

11	Please clarify the meaning of subconsultants. There is a confusion between Subcontractor and Sub Consultants, kindly clarify.	Subcontracting is not allowed. Please refer to Q&A EOI Conference No. 55.
