TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1 Bidders shall provide correct and accurate information required in this form.
- 2 Price quotation/s must be valid for a period of **thirty (30) calendar days** from the date of submission.
- 3 Price quotation/s, to be denominated in Philippine peso, shall include all taxes, duties and/or levies payable.
- 4 Quotations exceeding the ABC shall be rejected.
- 5 Award of contract shall be made to the lowest calculated and responsive bid (LCRB).
- 6 Any interlineations, erasures or overwriting shall be valid only if they are signed or initialed by you or your duly authorized representative.
- 7 In case of two or more bidders are determined to have submitted the LCRB, the PSA shall adopt and employ "draw lots" as the tie-breaking method to finally determine the single winning bidder in accordance with GPPB Circular 06-2005.
- 8 The item/s shall be delivered according to the requirements specified in the Purchase Request (PR).
- 9 The PSA shall have the right to inspect and/or test the goods to confirm their conformity to the Technical Specifications.
- 10 Payment shall be made after delivery and upon submission of the required supporting documents, i.e. Order Slip and/or Billing Statement, by the supplier. Our Government Servicing Bank, **Land Bank of the Philippines**, shall credit the amount due to the identified bank of the supplier **not earlier than twenty four (24) hours, but not later than forty eight (48) hours**, upon receipt of our advice. Please note that the corresponding **bank transfer fee**, if any, shall be chargeable to the account of the supplier.
- 11 Liquidated damages equivalent to one tenth (1/10) of one percent (1%) of the value of the goods not delivered within the prescribed period shall be imposed per day of delay. The PSA shall rescind the contract once the cumulative amount of liquidated damages reaches ten percent (10%) of the amount of the contract, without prejudice to other courses of action and remedies open to it.

ePhilID



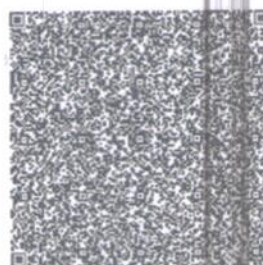
What is an ePhilID?

The ePhilID refers to the digital version of the PhilID which may be printed on a piece of paper or may be stored in the mobile device. It is a proactive strategy of the PSA that will allow more Filipinos to immediately enjoy the benefits of being PhilSys-registered.

Like the PhilID card, the ePhilID is **not a temporary ID**, has no expiration and shall be honored and accepted in all transactions requiring proof of identity and age as enumerated in Section 13 of Republic Act No. 11055 consistent with Executive Order No. 162, s. 2022, subject to proper authentication.



The ePhilID QR code



The ePhilID QR Code contains demographic information and a front-facing photo of the person.

It also uses public-private key cryptography to ensure that the information in the QR Code cannot be tampered with.

The ePhilID QR Code cannot be scanned using ordinary QR Code scanner applications.

Acceptance



The ePhilID shall be honored as the official government-issued identification document of a person.



An ePhilID photocopied or saved on the citizen's mobile phone is acceptable, subject to authentication.



The demographic information indicated in the ePhilID should match what is embedded in its QR Code.

Verify your ePhilID using



1. Go to verify.philsys.gov.ph.

2. Click the Scan QR Code button.



3. Allow your browser to use your device's camera.



4. Scan the ePhilID's QR Code.

Penalty

Section 19 of the Republic Act No. 11055 or the Philippine Identification System Act of 2018 states that any person or entity who without just and sufficient cause, shall refuse to accept, acknowledge and/or recognize the PhilID or PSN, subject to authentication, as the only official identification of the holder/possessor thereof shall be fined in the amount of Five hundred thousand pesos (P500,000.00).



a. Any person who utilizes the PhilID or PSN in an unlawful manner or use the same to commit any fraudulent act or for other unlawful purpose/s shall be punished with imprisonment of **not less than six (6) months but more than two (2) years** or a fine of **not less than Fifty thousand pesos (P50,000.00) but not more than Five hundred thousand pesos (P500,000.00)**, or both, at the discretion of the court.

b. The penalty of **three (3) to six (6) years imprisonment** and a fine of **One million (P1,000,000.00) to Three million pesos (P3,000,000.00)** shall be imposed upon any offender found guilty of any of the following acts or omissions: (d) The use of the PhilID/PSN or unauthorized possession of a PhilID, without any reasonable excuse by any person other than the one whom it was issued or the possession of a fake, falsified, or altered PhilID; or, (e) The wilful transfer of the PhilID or the PSN to any other person.
