

HOW DO I ACCESS THE PhilSys CHECK

1 Visit <https://verify.philsys.gov.ph>



2 Click **Scan QR Code** button



3 Scan the **QR Code** that is **printed on the back** of the PhilID Card



Minimum specifications of the devices needed to access the **PhilSys CHECK** are the following:



SMARTPHONES
Rear camera should be **13MP, 48MP, and 64MP with 1080-pixel resolution** and should have **no visual effects or enhancements**. The smartphones should also be running on an ***android operating system with versions 9 (Pie), 10 (Q), and 11 (R)** and **Google Chrome (version 98)** as the browser.
**Currently does not work on iOS device.*



LAPTOPS
Camera should be integrated with at least **2.1MP** and **720-pixel resolution**. The operating system should be **Windows 11** or **MacOS High Sierra**, with either **Google Chrome (version 98)** or **Mozilla Firefox (version 97)** as the browsers.

Based on testing, these devices successfully accessed the website:

WHAT ARE THE POSSIBLE VERIFICATION RESULTS?

For **successful verification**, the screen will display the demographic details of the cardholder.



For **unsuccessful verification**, which may result from PhilID misuse, reported loss, tampering, or damage, the screen will either show that the **PhilID has been revoked/inactive, or not recognized**.

The following are **not recommended** to be used in scanning the PhilID:

- ✗ **Photocopy** of the PhilID **saved in mobile device**
- ✗ **Printed scanned** copy of the PhilID
- ✗ **Printed photo** of the PhilID

WHAT IS Philsys CHECK?



Philsys CHECK is a website that uses public-private key cryptography which allows relying parties to verify the authenticity of digitally-signed demographic data stored in the QR code of the PhilID card. It is created primarily for identity verification in transactions.
